* **Collaborative art project:** Every Monday from July 9th to August 13th – from 2 to 3 PM. Help us create a beautiful piece of art for the Library. Drop-in activity for the whole family. All supplies provided. No registration required.

* **MakerSpace:** Every Friday from July 6th to August 17th – from 10 to 11 AM. If you can imagine it, you can build it! A cart full of supplies is at your disposal. Let your creativity burst! Activity for the whole family. Supervision is required for kids under 7 years old. No registration required.

- 3th **Transform into a bird:** Create a feathered mask and transform into a bird. (ages 7 to 12)
- 4th **Paint garden stone creatures:** Paint different creatures on stones to decorate your garden. (ages 5 to 12)
- 5th **Funny animals:** Draw animal parts and see what funny animals are created when you assemble them. (ages 7 to 12)
- 10th **Build a polar bear:** Mold clay into the shape of a friendly polar bear. (ages 7 to 12)
- 12th **A very fairy door:** Listen to author Carlie-Ann Brown's fairy story and install a fairy door in the Library's garden. (ages 3 to 10)
- 13th **Imaginary creatures:** Artist Shanna Steals will guide you through a painting of an imaginary creature (ages 7 to 12)
- 17th **Dragon yoga:** Participate in a yoga session with poses inspired by the life of dragons with Myriam Dessureault. (ages 7 to 12)
- 18th **Recycled magazine animals:** Make colourful silhouettes of animals with recycled magazine strips. (ages 6 to 12)
